**Years 4, 5 & 6 Outcomes**



**4.1 Living the Law of Love**

*Stage 2 Outcomes:*

- Attentive to ways in which they can apply the message of Jesus in reaching out and relating to others (VA)
- Identify the connection between the message of Jesus and their relationships
- Apply the message of Jesus in making decisions in their relationships with others

*Classroom Outcome:*

- Identify how individuals and organisations in the Church 'show they are Christians by their love'

**4.4 Pentecost: The Holy Spirit Gives Us Courage**

*Stage 2 Outcomes:*

- Able to value the lives of love and service led by saints
- Recognise qualities of saints who are models of love and service
- Make connections between the qualities of saints and their lives

*Classroom Outcomes:*

- Articulate how the saints needed courage to spread the Good News
- Identify situations when they need to speak and act with courage

**4.5 Mary, Mother of God: First Among the Saints**

*Stage 2 Outcomes:*

- Able to value the lives of love and service led by saints (including Mary and the canonised saints)
- Recognise qualities of saints (including Mary and the canonised saints) who are models of love and service
- Make connections between the qualities of saints (including Mary and the canonised saints) and their lives

*Classroom Outcome:*

- Recall how Mary MacKillop listened to god and responded to the needs of others

**5.1 The Reign of God: Reaching Out in Justice**

*Stage 3 Outcomes:*

- Aware of the Church's mission to reach out to others
- Explain the Church's mission to reach out to others
- Identify ways that they, as Church, can continue the mission of Jesus

*Classroom Outcome:*

- Describe how the Catholic community promotes justice

**5.2 Lent: A Time for Growth**

*Stage 3 Outcomes:*

- Aware of their responsibility to live according to the values of Jesus
- Explain the consequences of living according to the values of Jesus
- Analyse their own actions according to the values of Jesus

*Classroom Outcome:*

- Describe how they can grow, with the help of God's Holy Spirit, during times of rejection and difficulty

## **5.4 Pentecost: Celebrating the Presence of the Holy Spirit**

### *Stage 3 Outcomes:*

- Aware of the Church's mission to reach out to others
- Explain the Church's mission to reach out to others
- Identify ways that they, as Church, can continue the mission of Jesus

### *Classroom Outcome:*

- Identify how the good works of individuals reflect the presence of the Holy Spirit

## **6.1 The Reign of God: Breaking Down the Barriers**

### *Stage 3 Outcomes:*

- Able to accept responsibility as Christians to reach out in justice to others
- Identify ways in which people of God reach out, or fail to reach out to others
- Evaluate ways in which they can reach out in justice to build unity

### *Classroom Outcomes:*

- Analyse different ways by which individuals continue the mission of Jesus
- Explain how the Christian community responds to the marginalised

## **6.2 Lent: A Time for Building a Just World**

### *Stage 3 Outcomes:*

- Able to accept responsibility to reach out in justice to others as Christians
- Identify ways in which people of God reach out, and fail to reach out to others
- Evaluate ways in which they can reach out or fail to reach out, in justice to build unity

### *Classroom Outcome:*

- Describe how the Church, empowered by the Holy Spirit, lives the mission of Jesus

## **6.4 Confirmation: Celebrating the Gift of the Holy Spirit**

### *Stage 3 Outcomes:*

- Willing to accept their call to respond to God in their lives
- Identify challenges to respond to the presence of God
- Examine ways in which the liturgical year nourishes and challenges them to respond to the presence of God

### *Classroom Outcome:*

- Explain how the saints have lived the gifts of the Holy Spirit

## **6.5 Mary: Faithful Disciple**

### *Stage 3 Outcomes:*

- Able to value the beliefs and traditions which are founded on Scripture and expressed in the story of the Catholic Church
- Summarise the traditions and beliefs important to the life of the Catholic Church
- Research traditions and beliefs of the Catholic Church

### *Classroom Outcome:*

- Identify women who are models of faith and courage and describe how they live their faith in God
