24E1 Mission: Serving Others with Jesus

Stage 2 Outcome:

- Students demonstrate an understanding and appreciation of Christian life as making loving choices in following the teachings and example of Jesus

Unit Outcomes:

- Recognise examples of service within their own communities and throughout the world
- Explain the meaning of mission as service which was modelled and taught by Jesus in 'Jesus Washes the Disciples' Feet (Jn 13:1-15) and The Parable of the Good Samaritan (Lk 10:25-37)
- Describe ways they can be of service to others throughout the world

35C4 Stories of the Early Church

Stage 3 Outcome:

- Students demonstrate an understanding and appreciation of the Church as being led by the Holy Spirit, as honouring Mary and as having a life and mission in which individuals are called to various ministries of service

Unit Outcomes:

- Recall events that evoke memories of significant people
- Appreciate how the Holy Spirit is at work in our community through the mission of the Church

35C6 Living the Message of Jesus

Stage 3 Outcome:

- Students demonstrate an understanding and appreciation of Christian life as responding to God's love of us and of all creation, through the strength of the Holy Spirit

Unit Outcomes:

- Recognise that we are responsible for the decisions we make and their consequences
- Identify and evaluate the ways in which people influence our decision making
- Interpret and apply Scripture stories which challenge us to live Christian lives
- Appreciate the different ways in which Christians can lead and serve others

35E2 Mission: Witnessing and Proclaiming Jesus throughout the World

Stage 3 Outcome:

- Students demonstrate an understanding and appreciation of Christian life as responding to God's love of us and of all creation, through the strength of the Holy Spirit.

Unit Outcomes:

- Analyse the message and meaning of the Mission of Jesus in Luke 4:16-22
- Identify stories and examples of people who witness and proclaim the Good News of Jesus either locally or globally
- Identify practical ways in which they can share with others in Jesus' mission to the poor and oppressed

36C1 Servant Leadership

Stage 3 Outcome:

- Students demonstrate an understanding and appreciation of Christian life as responding to God's love of us and of all creation, through the strength of the Holy Spirit

Unit Outcomes:

- Compare and contrast different styles of leadership
- Identify and explain characteristics of servant leadership displayed by Moses and Jesus
- Apply the Christian ideals of leadership in their school community

36C4 The Story of the Catholic Church in Australia

Stage 3 Outcome:

- Students demonstrate an understanding and appreciation of the Church as being led by the Holy Spirit, as honouring Mary and as having a life and mission in which individuals are called to various ministries of service

Unit Outcomes:

- Outline the way of life and faith of Australian Catholics in the early years of European settlement
- Recount the story and contribution of one significant Australian Catholic
- Develop and awareness and appreciation of the importance of Catholic schools as major activity of the Australian Catholic Church
- Recognise the richness of the various expressions and rites of Catholicism that make up the Catholic Church in Australia

36E1 Heroes for God

Stage 3 Outcomes:

- Students demonstrate an understanding and appreciation of Jesus, present in our lives in many ways, offering hope to the world

Unit Outcomes:

- Identify the qualities of role models
- Appreciate the attributes of past and present Kingdom people
- Evaluate their lives as Kingdom people today

Stage 3 Outcome:

- Students demonstrate an understanding and appreciation of Christian life as responding to God's love of us and of all creation, through the strength of the Holy Spirit

Unit Outcomes:

- Analyse the meaning of mission in Mt 25:34-40 and Mt 28:16-20
- Recognise in the lives of others a commitment to the mission of Jesus
- Name ways they can continue the mission of Jesus
