**Community of Believers**

*Stage 2 Outcome:*

- Identify the Church as a community that celebrates the life and work of Jesus

*Unit Outcomes:*

- Analyse Scripture passages that tell about the life and love of Jesus
- Identify the ways in which Jesus encouraged his followers to live
- Describe ways in which the Holy Spirit is active in the community of believers

**Following Jesus**

*Stage 2 Outcome:*

- Investigate how Christians make loving choices that are informed by the example of Jesus

*Unit Outcomes:*

- Explain how the teachings of Jesus can help them make appropriate choices
- Examine how Jesus' parables invited people to think about the way they were living
- Demonstrate how Jesus' commandment to 'Love one another as I have love you' can be applied to their relationships with others
- Identify ways in which situations of injustice and conflict challenge us to think about the way we live our lives today

**Reaching Out**

*Stage 2 Outcome:*

- Investigate how Christians make loving choices that are informed by the example of Jesus

*Unit Outcomes:*

- Explain how a person's relationship with Jesus influences how they treat others
- Identify some of the features and challenges of mission as Jesus' disciples
- Give examples of Christian missionary actions and programs that reach out to others in need

**Celebrating the Gift of the Spirit**

*Stage 2 Outcome:*

- Identify the Church as a community that celebrates the life and work of Jesus

*Unit Outcomes:*

- Explain how the Holy Spirit is present in the Church today
- Identify ways the Holy Spirit is present in all member of the Church.

**The Church in Australia**

*Stage 3 Outcome:*

- Identify the Church as a community that celebrates the life and work of Jesus

*Unit Outcomes:*

- Identify the men and women who, with the help of the Holy Spirit, shaped and inspired the development of the Australian Catholic Church
- Recount the story of one significant Australian Catholic, exploring how their faith enabled them to carry out their mission
- Research and summarise the story of their own parish community

**Living as Disciples**

*Stage 3 Outcome:*

- Investigate how Christians make loving choices that are informed by the example of Jesus

*Unit Outcomes:*

- Explore issues of social justice and the implications for our world
- Analyse the message and meaning of the Beatitudes
- Identify stories and people today who witness and proclaim the good News of Jesus both locally and globally
- Determine ways in which they can make a personal response to the Beatitudes now and in the future

**Witnessing and Proclaiming**

*Stage 3 Outcome:*

- Investigate how Christians make loving choices that are informed by the example of Jesus

*Unit Outcomes:*

- Analyse the message and meaning of the mission of Jesus in Luke 4:16-22
- Identify stories and examples of people who witness and proclaim the Good News of Jesus either locally or globally
- Identify practical ways in which they can share with others in Jesus' mission to the poor and oppressed

**Living and Sharing**

*Stage 3 Outcome:*

- Investigate how Christians make loving choices that are informed by the example of Jesus

*Unit Outcomes:*

- Justify their understanding of mission by drawing on Scripture passages
- Identify ways in which they can continue the mission of Jesus

- Identify the meaning of the feast of Pentecost and its historical association with the Festival of Weeks
