

DIORAMAS

A diorama is a model that represents a scene, a favourite book or a theme such as Christmas or Easter. It can be three-dimensional, and on a small or large scale.

It is so much fun to make and exciting to play with.

FIRST, plan the scene or theme you would like to portray

SECOND, you will need:

- a large, strong shoe box (or any sturdy box),
- scissors
- craft glue
- paints or crayons
- cardboard, paper
- playdough, cotton wool, glitter



Cut away one of the long sides of the box and put in background scenery by painting or using coloured paper with cut-out figures or magazines cuttings - BE AS CREATIVE AS YOU WANT!!!!

(Younger children will need assistance with cutting sides of the box).
