The young Irish women, who dedicated their lives to the Sisters of St Joseph at this time, are an inspiration. The women on leaving Ireland faced permanent separation from family and rural isolation in outback communities in a country radically foreign to Irish sensibilities. These women were not alone in a period in Australia history that would embrace thousands of new emigrants from Ireland settling in Australia.
